


Wooden Ruler Rack Assembly Instructions


Assembly Tools:




The ruler rack ships disassembled. It is relatively easy to put together. Four screws are in the box to attach the ruler rack to the feet. The feet on the bottom of the ruler provide a stable base. You will need the following items for assembly:

- (1) Wooden Ruler Rack (A)
- (2) Wooden Rack Feet (B)
- (4) Screws (C)

You will also need a Small Philip Screw Driver for the Screws.



Step 1: With the Wood Rack (A) rackside facing you, flip to the bottom and find the (4) small holes.



Step 2: Flip the Wooden Rack Feet (B) to the bottom and find the (2) big holes. Place the Screws (C) into the holes with a light push until they feel secure in the holes.





Step 3: Hold the screws in place as you align the holes from the top of the Wood Rack Feet (B) with the bottom holes of Wooden Rack (A) as closely as possible.



Step 4: Securely hold the Wooden Rack Foot (B) to the Wooden Rack (A) and using Small Philips Screw Driver, screw the Screws (C) until the screws pierce into the bottom of the Wooden Rack (A) and securely hold in place. Repeat this step for the other Wooden Rack Foot (B).



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Step 5: Flip the Wooden Ruler Rack so the feet are at the bottom and make sure the feet are secure. If so, the Wooden Ruler Rack is ready to use.
